



Role: Project Manager (Social Impact Campaigns)

Eski is looking to add to our team a Project Manager with a passion for marketing and communications and a genuine interest in positive social change.

This role sits at the heart of our work as social impact media partners, supporting the co-production and delivery of campaigns that make a practical difference within communities. The kind of person who will thrive here is likely to be more motivated by social outcomes than commercial marketing, comfortable working with clients in a professional environment, and confident taking responsibility for multiple projects at different stages.

The work isn't always glamorous, but it is meaningful through seeing the positive outcomes of campaigns that help people to be safer, healthier and happier.

Eski is a dedicated and collaborative team, working closely with clients, partners and communities to deliver early intervention and prevention media programmes across a range of health and social issues. Recent projects have included helping people to stop smoking, overcome barriers to work, get an earlier cancer diagnosis, understand how to act as an active bystander, and protect themselves and their friends from crime.

Although there is room for creativity, this role best suits someone who is highly organised, strong on administration, and confident communicating clearly and professionally with a wide range of people.

After an initial period supporting campaign and project leads, we would expect the successful candidate to progress into confidently managing client projects of their own.

The role will require you to:

- Set and manage project budgets.
- Take briefs from clients and prepare quotes.
- Document, track and report on projects internally and externally.
- Support the internal delivery team with accurate information and ideas.
- Work with suppliers to agree fair and effective services.
- Represent Eski and client projects at meetings and events.
- Start and run small to medium-sized projects and campaigns.

Currently, Eski works in a hybrid way, with an expectation that full-time team members work regularly from our base at the Aura Innovation Centre, Bridgehead Park, Hessle.
